INSPIRATION

Created exclusively for our Club PEJU members, 'The Old Victorian' pays homage to the old Victorian house that has watched time march by over over a century. Located on our Persephone estate vineyard, the house was built in 1915 for a family running cattle through the valley.

VINTAGE

The 2021 vintage will be remembered for low yields with intensely-flavored, small-sized berries, and a smooth harvest season. The season started off with very little rain, leading to the 2nd year of drought conditions in Napa Valley. The drought of 2021 resulted in a more natural load on the vines, requiring less pruning and dropping of fruit. The resulting grapes were packed full of flavor.

TASTING

Our 2021 'The Old Victorian' is a testament to Sara Fowler's blending ability, showcasing a delicacy while striking a perfect balance, making it a timeless Bordeaux Blend. On the nose, notes of violet entice, hinting at the elegance to come. As it caresses the palate, a smooth and luscious profile emerges, with flavors of dark chocolate and fresh plum taking the spotlight. The wine's juiciness is undeniable, while a subtle cigar spice characteristic adds depth and intrigue.
