# 2021 THE FARM, NAPA VALLEY

#### **INSPIRATION**

Created exclusively for our Club PEJU members, 'The Farm' pays homage to the 350-acre parcel Tony and HB purchased in 1996, renamed Persephone. Once a cattle ranch, the Peju family has since planted vineyards on the estate, yet the original red barn still remains, harkening back to the days when the property was a working farm.

### **VINTAGE**

The 2021 vintage will be remembered for low yields with intensely-flavored, small-sized berries, and a smooth harvest season. The season started off with very little rain, leading to the 2nd year of drought conditions in Napa Valley. The drought of 2021 resulted in a more natural load on the vines, requiring less pruning and dropping of fruit. The resulting grapes were packed full of flavor.

#### TASTING

Our 2021 'The Farm'is a delightful blend of Sangiovese and Cabernet that captures the essence of freshness and brightness in every sip. This wine opens with lovely aromatics and a bouquet of red fruits, and a subtle hint of cocoa that adds depth. 'The Farm' unfolds like a charming symphony of flavors, with notes of strawberry rhubarb pie taking the lead. Cedar box nuances provide a touch of sophistication, while a hint of cinnamon adds a warm and comforting element. This wine offers a fresh and delicate profile that is both approachable and complex, making it a true gem from our "farm".
